Registration

Registration will be online at www.judgingcard.com . You will use your chapter number as your user name and password. Schools will be assessed a \$35.00 registration fee which you can mail in ahead of time. Registration fee for those schools providing buses will be waived. **Registration deadline is Monday, March 22th, 2010.**

Late registration will be accepted however an additional \$5.00 late fee will be charged. Late registrants may pay on site the day of contest.

All contestants are to meet in the Crowder Gymnasium at 8:00 a.m. for announcements. Contests begin promptly at 9:00 a.m.

The three high individual scores will make up the team score. Hardcopy scorecards will be provided for those contests requiring and ID sheet.

Contests will be set up to follow as closely as possible the guidelines given in the Missouri Agricultural Education Contest Bulletin.

Trophies to be Awarded

A team trophy or plaque will be awarded to each of the top three teams in each contest.

A medal will be awarded to three high individuals in each contest.

A sweepstakes, reserve sweepstakes and runner-up sweepstakes trophy will be awarded to three schools with the highest number of points. Multi teacher departments must accumulate 33% more points than single teacher departments. Points for the sweepstakes trophy will be figured as follows:
