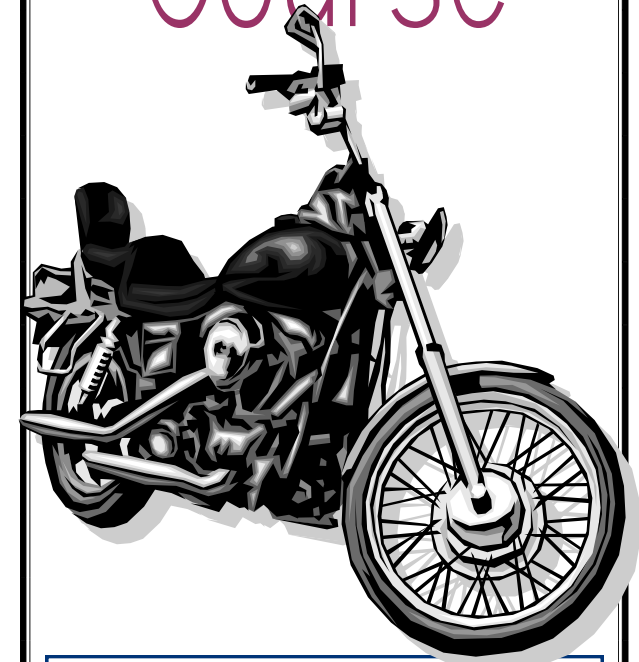

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the Motorcycle Rider Program is to provide quality instruction in safe riding techniques for beginning motorcyclists. Our goal is to increase your skill level and knowledge, in an attempt to produce a safe and conscientious motorcyclists.

## BASIC RIDER COURSE (BRC)

The Basic Rider Course is designed to provide a foundation of knowledge and skills for people who have never ridden, as well as those who have ridden up to 10,000 miles. Motorcycles and helmets are provided.

Non-motorcyclists can benefit from this course by learning on a first-hand basis what a motorcyclist experience and the necessity for developing respect for all vehicles on the roadway. The novice or occasional rider can benefit in the areas of skill development with emphasis for survival as a street rider.

Because the BRC course can be taken in lieu of the range-riding portion of the Department of Revenue license examination, successful completion of a written and skills evaluation is required to pass the course. Those who successfully complete the course will be issued a completion card from the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, which is recognized by many insurance companies for premium discounts.

## ELIGIBILITY

In order to register for the **BRC**, participants must be 15 1/2 years of age or older (parental consent required for 15 1/2 - 17 year olds).
