CROWDER COLLEGE TWO-DAY AMLS TRAINING

NEOSHO, MO – Crowder College Paramedic Program Director, Kristin Spencer, has scheduled a two-day Advanced Medical Life Support (AMLS) training on the campus in Neosho, January 13-14.

AMLS training is geared for nurses, doctors, and paramedics. This two-day certification class helps those in charge of assessing medical patients to “think outside the box” and use their critical thinking skills for common types of medical complaints (e.g., altered mental status, chest pain, abdominal pain, etc.).

The sessions will be taught by textbook authors Mr. Greg Clarkes, Canadian College of EMS and Mr. Brad Pierson, Advanced Medical Life Support Committee member, paramedic and arson investigator.

Upon successful completion of this training Spencer will become a certified AMLS trainer allowing her to teach the classes and making Crowder an official AMLS training site.
