Neosho, MO – The Crowder College Nursing program received approval for an accelerated program that is scheduled to begin July 5, 2011. The program is open to Paramedics, EMT's, or an active Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) with some requirements.

Students must have completed Anatomy and Physiology I and II, have a minimum 2.75 gpa and composite ACT score or 19 or better. The program will run four days a week for the month of July with forty-eight hours of clinical and simulations completed in August. Students will then enter the regular program at Neosho for the Fall 2011 and Spring 2012. They will complete the program in the Summer of 2012 with 8 weeks of courses and clinicals.

This allows a student who is currently working in a health related area the opportunity to bypass the first semester of the nursing program at Neosho by taking the accelerated summer option.
