Neosho, MO - Crowder College's College Assistance Migrant Program (CAMP) received word that the grant would be funded for another year with anticipation that it would continue for a total of 5 years. This grant is provided by the US Department of Education in the amount of \$403,990 annually.

CAMP was developed to assist students that are engaged, or whose parents are engaged in migrant and other seasonal farmwork, and are enrolled or are admitted for enrollment on a full-time basis in the first academic year at an institution of higher education.
