Crowder College Receives Disaster Relief Fund for Student

Neosho, MO - Crowder College will receive \$15,000 in disaster relief funds to be distributed to students adversely affected by the tornado in Joplin. This grant is made possible through contributions to Scholarship American from USA Funds.

Students must be enrolled at least half-time (minimum 6 credit hours per term) at Crowder College to qualify. The funds are to be used to supplement financial aid packages for students who have experienced additional financial difficulties related to the recent weather even. Students must be Pell Grant eligible to participate in this assistance to be used for tuition, fees, books, room and board/housing and food, or other education-related expenses as determined by Crowder College Financial Aid Officers.
