RE: Crowder College Awards Disaster Relief Funds to Students

Neosho, MO – Crowder College is awarding nearly \$35,000 to over 70 Crowder College students who were affected by the May 22nd tornado. The money came from USA Funds and private donations made to the Crowder College Foundation.

To receive the USA Funds a student had to be taking at least 6 hours and be eligible for financial aid. This allowed the college to assist students with amounts ranging from \$100 to \$600 depending on their situation. Once the USA Funds were awarded the Foundation supplemented some and awarded others who did not qualify for the grant funding.

The generous donations from the community will help these students with expenses such as tuition, fees, books, room and board, housing, and other education-related items.

“We have such faithful and generous donors who respond when there is a need. The grant helped us to stretch those donations farther, which allowed us to assist more students and give larger awards” stated Pam Hudson, Director of Developments and Grants.
