Crowder MARET Center Energy Excellence Award - The MARET Center Energy Excellence Award will be given to recognize a Four-State area business that demonstrates outstanding effort in instituting, utilizing, or providing energy efficiency or energy efficient products or services.

Excellence in Environmental Stewardship Award - The Eastern Shawnee Longhouse Management Authority Excellence in Environmental Stewardship Award will be given to recognize a Four-State area business that demonstrates outstanding effort in instituting, utilizing or providing successful environmental projects and/or conservation measures.
