Neosho, MO – The Crowder College Transport Training Program will relocate the donation trailer to the Wal-Mart parking lot on Monday, May 30. It will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. accepting donations including:

- Blankets
- Toiletries
- Non-Perishable food
- Formula
- Diapers
- Wipes
- Cleaning Supplies
- Bleach
- Large Trash Bags

The Crowder College Foundation will accept tax-deductible to assist Crowder Staff & Students affected by the storm. Nine faculty and staff members at Crowder College suffered injuries and loss or major damage to their homes during the May 22 tornado. They are thankful that family members are safe, but have immediate needs for shelter and assistance. The Crowder College Foundation has set up a fund for cash donations.
