

COMMUNITY COLLEGE PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIPS TO MSU AND MU FOR FALL 2012

Each spring Missouri State University in Springfield and Missouri University in Columbia offer Community College Transfer Scholarships (two for each school) to Crowder students who are transferring, based on the recommendation of Crowder President, Alan D. Marble, Ph.D. To be eligible for the scholarships, students must have either an Associate Degree or sixty hours of transferable credit and be in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50.

Application forms are available on Crowder's website, from the President's Office at 417-455-5534 or via email to MarthaNimmo@crowder.edu . Applications must be typed, completed, signed and returned to the President's Office by **5:00 PM, Thursday, April 5th**. Recipients are selected shortly thereafter by the President and a Scholarship Committee based on criteria including academic achievement at Crowder, academic promise, citizenship, co-curricular activity, and the potential to be an outstanding student at MSU or MU.

The MSU "Community College Scholarship" is valued at \$2,000 per academic year and is renewable for one additional year if a recipient completes 30 hours the first year and achieves at least a 3.40 cumulative grade point average.

The MU "Missouri Community College Scholar Award" is valued at \$2,000 per academic year and is renewable for one additional year if the recipient completes 24 hours the first year and achieves at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.

Other transfer scholarships are also available at these schools as well as at many other colleges and universities in Missouri.
