

How do I get credit for CLEP?

When you take a CLEP exam, you can select the institution that should receive your scores. Select **Crowder College** to have your scores sent here. An official score report will automatically be forwarded to the school. You will also receive an unofficial Candidate Score Report for your records immediately after the examination (except for College Composition with Essay for English credit).

Be Informed! What is the CLEP?

- ◆ CLEP is a series of examinations that allow individuals to earn college credit for what they know, regardless of where they learned it.
- ◆ CLEP exams are 90 minutes long, (120 min for College Composition) and are administered *only on computer*. Students receive instant score reports at the end of their exam, except College Composition, which will be sent in to CLEP for grading.

What should I bring on exam day?

Please bring two forms of identification to the test center. Your primary ID must include your photo and signature; e.g. a driver's license or passport. Your secondary ID must have a signature and/or photo; e.g. a social security card or student ID card.

Note: Student/college ID cards are acceptable only as a secondary form of ID. NOTHING is allowed in the test room except for CLEP official scratch paper (will be provided). A calculator is provided on the computer if your exam allows you to use one. Each exam lasts approximately two hours. Please plan accordingly. Candidates with disabilities who require accommodations must make arrangements well in advance of the test date.

Test Dates: by appointment only

Payments: there will be two separate non-refundable payments totaling \$92.

- ◆ **Administration Fee:** \$15, (cash, check, or credit card) payable to Crowder College.
- ◆ **CLEP Exam Fee:** \$77 payable by credit/debit card (preferably), and goes directly to CLEP. CLEP also accepts a personal check. You can also pay by cash (exact amount, the ARC does not have cash on hand).

Other Important Information About Our CLEP Policy:

Crowder College students may earn up to 15 credits with CLEP exams, or other alternative learning experiences including: Experiential Credit and Self-Directed Learning. *Check with your advisor* for more information.

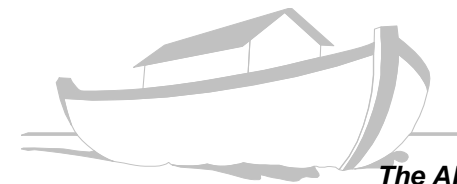
Students may not repeat an exam within 6 months of the testing date. CLEP exams repeated earlier than 6 months will be canceled and your test fees will be forfeited.

NOTE: If you fail a class, a passing CLEP score DOES NOT replace the grade of the failed class. The "F" will remain on your transcript, however, you will receive credit for the class.
