



## International Scholarship Application

Dear Student,

We are very proud to offer this exciting new opportunity for students to help to fund their education. This scholarship opportunity is for both International and Domestic students to continue and extend their studies at Crowder College. The scholarship has been approved by the Crowder College Scholarship Committee for the following reasons:

- To allow students to fund their studies abroad. Due to income levels in the area, studying abroad is often cost-prohibitive for many of the students interested in pursuing education overseas. There are additional costs for transportation, fees, insurance, and increased costs for tuition. These students would experience the same level of financial burden as those that International Students experience when studying at Crowder College.
- To allow students to apply for funds for emergency purposes, due to sponsorship difficulties beyond their control. ie. Violence in home country, Sponsor's Medical and financial emergencies, exceptional and extenuating circumstances.
- To allow International Students the opportunity to fund their education here at Crowder College. On-campus employment is limited here at Crowder and International Student's tuition per credit hour is higher than a domestic student's per credit hour tuition cost. International Students are also required to obtain insurance, which is an additional cost that most domestic students are not required to purchase themselves because they are usually covered on their parent's insurance plan. Car insurance and other costs that we take for granted are often higher due to the student's lack of social security number, residency, and status.

The scholarships for International Students would be available based on International Office Committee application selection. Eligible students must maintain a minimum 3.0 Cumulative G.P.A, maintain their F-1 Visa Status, and enroll in and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester. International Students who obtain the scholarship one semester would be able to re-apply for another scholarship the following semester. Students interested in Studying Abroad would be eligible for a scholarship if they have at least a 3.0 cumulative G.P.A and are full-time students. These students will be expected to complete a project assigned by the International Coordinator after returning from their travel.
