

Your application was selected for review in a process called "Verification." In this process, Crowder will be comparing information from your application with **SIGNED copies of your 2008 FEDERAL tax forms including all schedules and W-2 forms** (and your spouse's if you are married, or parents' if you are considered dependent for federal aid purposes), or other financial documents. The law says we have the right to ask you for this information before awarding Federal aid. If there are differences between your application information and financial documents, corrections will be submitted by our office. If your award changes as the result of a correction, you will receive an updated Student Aid Report from the Central Processor. Verification must be completed before aid is awarded and no later than 120 days after your last date of attendance or September 28, 2010, whichever is

earlier. Failure to complete the verification process voids all Federal awards.

What you should do:

1. Collect your (and your spouse's or parent(s)') financial documents (signed federal income tax forms, W-2, etc.).
2. Speak to the financial aid office if you have questions about completing this worksheet.
3. Forward the completed, signed worksheet, tax forms, and any required documents to the financial aid office.
4. The financial aid office will compare information on these documents and make corrections if necessary.

Your school must review the requested information, under the financial aid program rules (34 CFR, Part 668).
