ACT placement levels:

Math subscore: 22

Places into College Algebra – Math 111 or Introduction to Mathematics – Math 107

Reading subscore: 18

Places at the college level reading, allows students to take a number of social science, history courses, and meets the requirements for taking online courses

English subscore: 19

Places into college level English – English 101 English Composition

If students do not take the ACT exam, and/or do not obtain the above listed subscore, students will need to take the COMPASS exam. The COMPASS exam is required of all first time students who are seeking a degree, enrolling for 7 credit hours or more, or enrolling for a course that has a placement requirement. Transfer students who have not completed their freshman requirements in English and/or math will be required to take the Crowder College placement exams or provide adequate ACT scores. Students who have completed 6 hours will be required to take placement exams prior to enrolling in additional coursework.

College level COMPASS placement levels:

Math: 54-100, within the “Algebra” math test domain (there are 4 domains), or 0-100, within the “College Algebra” math test domain, or 0-50 within the “Trigonometry” math test domain

**students scoring higher than College Algebra, or within the Trigonometry domain can place into upper level math courses such as Trigonometry or Calculus (depending on the score)

English: 70-94, within the “Writing” test domain

Reading: 80-100, within the “Reading” test domain

Developmental level COMPASS placements:

- Students who do not meet college level placement with either ACT or COMPASS test scores will be placed in the following developmental courses:

MATH 40: 0-44, within the “pre-Algebra” domain

MATH 50: 45-100, within the “pre-Algebra” domain, or 0-32 within the “Algebra” domain

MATH 100: 33-53, within the “Algebra” domain

COMM 80: 0-35, within the “Writing” domain

ENG 100: 40-69, within the “Writing domain

LOC 40: 0-59, within the “Reading” domain

LOC 50: 60-69, within the “Reading” domain

LOC 90: 70-79, within the “Reading” domain
