

CROWDER CONNECTION IN-STATE TUITION SCHOLARSHIP

For students from ARKANSAS, KANSAS & OKLAHOMA

The Program

Qualifying students who are residents of Arkansas, Kansas or Oklahoma will be granted the in-state tuition rates, a \$27 per credit hour discount. The number of grantees are limited to 100, on a first come/first serve basis.

Residency Qualifications

Students must be able to produce evidence of residency that includes the following:

1. A current Real Estate or Personal Property tax receipt, or
2. Rental Agreement or records of monthly receipts to evidence at least one year of residence, or
3. Employment Transfer.

Eligible students may attend classes at our main campus in Neosho, or at our Cassville, Nevada or Webb City campuses.

To qualify you must:

1. Be a high school graduate
2. Have a 3.0 cumulative high school G.P.A. on a 4.0 scale, or
3. Have a 21 composite score on the ACT, or
4. Be a GED graduate with a score of 500 or above, or
5. Be a transfer student with 12 credit hours and a 2.75 G.P.A.
6. Be among the first 100 students to apply for the scholarship
7. Apply for admission to Crowder College
