

### General Description

This program offers the graduate an Associate of Applied Science degree (AAS) which provides education for a specific career. Graduates are prepared for the world of work upon successful completion of the program. While an AAS is not designed to transfer, it is possible to transfer to a four-year college if planned accordingly. Students planning to transfer should consult their faculty advisor before registering for classes to assure appropriate classes are selected.

Internships can be paid, unpaid or partially paid through a stipend. They can be either part-time or full-time either during the school year or in the summer, and usually last for about 6-12 weeks, but can be shorter or longer depending on the needs of the company and how the student negotiates it.

Co-op Employment Opportunities help students combine classroom learning with real-world work experience where students can alternate classroom study with six-month periods of paid employment in jobs connected to their academic, career or personal interests.
