

Federal Direct Student Loan Exit Counseling

Federal regulations require student loan borrowers to complete Exit Loan Counseling upon fulfilling graduation requirements, or if you withdraw from all classes, or if you drop below half-time enrollment.

Crowder College graduates' average loan indebtedness for loans borrowed while attending Crowder College is approximately \$6314. The monthly payment on this amount is approximately \$64.80. This monthly payment is based on the maximum Federal Direct Student Loan interest rate of 4.29% for 10 years, as of February 5, 2016 and is subject to change.
