In line with the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education all programs across the state, including Crowder College Adult Education and Literacy, will soon be moving away from the 2002 paper/pencil GED®/High School Equivalency test. Crowder AEL will begin helping people prepare to take a new computer-based test in 2014.

For those who wish to take the current version of the test before January, GED applications are due to DESE no later than September 1, 2013. The test takers who attempted the test, but did not successfully complete, the application is due to DESE by November 4, 2013.
