KSN Presents Evening of Jazz to Benefit Crowder College Foundation

Neosho, MO—Crowder College Foundation will partner with KSN to present the 5th Annual *Evening of Jazz* Tuesday, April 29 at the Neosho Civic. The event begins with a wine and hors d'oeuvres mixer at 6 pm followed by a live jazz performance by Crowder Jazz Orchestra at 7 pm. KSN Chief Meteorologist Gary Bandy will serve as master of ceremonies for the evening. Additional sponsors include Community Bank & Trust and Southwest Missouri Bank. Proceeds from the event will provide scholarship assistance for students with limited financial resources.
