2014 Soccer Match Recaps

Season Record 8-8 Overall, 1-4 in Region 16 play

October 18, 2014 – Crowder vs. Northern Oklahoma (Loss 5-1)

Northern Oklahoma opened the scoring in the first minute.

Marco Collina equalized three minutes later.

Northern Oklahoma scored four minutes after that, then again and again before halftime.

They added one more after halftime making the final score 1-5.

October 7, 2014 – Crowder vs. Oklahoma Wesleyan (Loss 0-1)

First half miscue put the Riders behind 0-1 at half. The riders were unable to score despite several excellent opportunities. Shutout for the third game in a row!

October 4, 2014 – Crowder vs. Jefferson Community College (Loss 0-1)

Long trip to Hillsboro. 0-0 at half. Penalty kick 5 minutes into the second half. Never able to recover from that losing 0-1.

September 30, 2014 – Crowder vs. NEO (Loss 0-1)

A deflected free kick caught goalkeeper Logan Mattix going the wrong way early in the first half and the Riders were unable to find the back of the net despite several excellent opportunities.

September 28, 2014 – Crowder vs. Wentworth Military College (Win 1-0)

While dominating possession the majority of the game, the Riders waited until the last second of the match to score. Connor Poellot served a cross to Tem Shetley for a driving header and the game winner.

September 23, 2014 - Crowder vs. Blue River (Loss 0-1)

The first half started slow as Crowder gave up a goal in a goalmouth scramble making the score 0-1 at halftime. The second half faired little better as a Red Card and missed penalty kick were too much to overcome. Blue River won 1-0 as the Riders were shutout for the first time this season.

September 20, 2014 – Crowder vs. East Central (Win 4-1)

Falling behind 0-1 seemed to be what the riders needed to wake them up. Joe Rice equalized before half time. A second half goal by Yonas Girma and two by Dan Collins sealed the win.

September 16, 2014 - Maple Woods vs. Crowder (Loss 1-3)

September 13, 2014 - Crowder vs. Indian Hills (Win 1-0)

September 6, 2014 – Crowder vs. St. Louis CC (Loss 1-2)

Two defensive errors were too much for the young riders to overcome despite a well taken penalty kick by Dan Collins and possessing the ball for the majority of the game. Disappointing and encouraging at the same time.

September 2, 2014 - Crowder vs. Mountain View (Win 1-0)
