### CROWDER College

Crowder College offers Academic, Departmental, Athletic, Performance and Foundation Scholarships intended to assist students and their families in meeting college expenses. Eligibility criteria, deadlines and award amounts should be reviewed when applying for scholarships. The following scholarship information pertains to Crowder College Scholarships. Multiple scholarships may be awarded based on student need and eligibility requirements.

## **ACADEMIC** SCHOLARSHIPS

### Presidential Honors\* (Full tuition, fees and books)

- Must apply and be accepted to Crowder's Honors Program. Applications and eligibility information available at: www.Crowder.edu/Academics/Honors
- Renewable for up to three consecutive semesters with 3.5 cumulative GPA, completion of at least 15 credit hours per semester and a "B" or above in all Honors coursework
- Fall priority deadline is April 1

### Superintendent's Scholarship\* (\$700 per semester, fall & spring, toward tuition, fees and book loan)

- Chosen by superintendents of Crowder In-District schools from the top 10% of the graduating high school class
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with 3.0 GPA and minimum 15 hours per semester
- Interested students should inquire at the Superintendent's Office of their school district

### Trustees\* (\$600 per semester, fall & spring, applied to tuition and fees)

- High school seniors graduating from an accredited Missouri high school, ranking in the top 15% of their class OR
- Missouri students scoring a 25 or higher on the ACT (Includes high school and home school graduates.)
- Renewable up to 3 consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Inquire at Financial Aid Office

### Student Ambassador (\$800 per semester, fall & spring)

- Students are required to work a minimum of 10 hours per week in Admissions Office
- Renewable up to six consecutive semesters with 2.5 GPA and minimum 12 hours completed per semester
- Scholarship prorated for summer semester and A+ students
- Applications available online at Crowder.edu/financial-aid/scholarships/student-ambassadors

#### Resident Assistantship (Room and board)

- Requires recipient to live in college student housing, work in various campus offices and be on call for emergencies
- May be renewed up to three semesters with 2.5 cumulative GPA and minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Inquire of Director of Campus Life

### **Career & Technical Education** (\$800 per semester-top ranked senior, \$400 per semester-2nd ranked senior from Technology Centers in Carthage, Crowder-Neosho, Lamar, Franklin-Joplin, Nevada & Scott - Monett)

- Full-time enrollment within 1 year of high school graduation
- May be renewed up to 3 consecutive semesters with 3.0 cumulative GPA and successful completion of 12 credit hours each semester

# **CROWDER COLLEGE** SCHOLARSHIPS

### High School Equivalency (formerly GED) Scholarship (\$600 per semester, fall & spring tuition and fees)

- Any student who passed the High School Equivalency in Missouri, with a minimum score of 75
- The initial award must be used within the first year following completion
- Eligible students must maintain and successfully complete full-time status with a 3.0 GPA
- Students who pass the High School Equivalency with a score lower than the scholarship standard are eligible for a three-credit hour, in-district, tuition waiver. This is a one-time non-renewable scholarship
- Inquire at Financial Aid Office

### International (Amounts vary)

- Be a Crowder College International student with at least a 3.0 GPA
- Enroll in and successfully complete 12 credit hours, must maintain their F-1 visa and participate in International Club activities and service opportunities
- Inquire of International Student Affairs Coordinator

### Language Enrichment (Amounts vary)

- This scholarship is for non-native English speakers that desire to attend classes at Crowder
- Renewable for 3 additional semesters if the recipient completes 12 credit hours per semester and has a 3.0 GPA
- Inquire of English Language Coordinator

## **DEPARTMENTAL** SCHOLARSHIPS

### Agriculture, Art & Design, Business & Office Administration, Environmental Health, Career & Technical Education, Journalism, Music, Social Sciences, Teacher Education, Spanish, Speech/Debate, and Theatre

- Eligible students must maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and be enrolled in and successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester.
- Scholarships may be renewed for up to three consecutive semesters provided the student maintains the required minimum GPA & credit hours.
- Scholarship amounts may vary and will be determined by the division chair.
- Interested students should inquire through the appropriate Crowder College Department.

## **PERFORMANCE/ATHLETIC** SCHOLARSHIPS

- Eligible students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA and meet departmental/athletic requirements.
- Auditions, tryouts, and/or portfolios may also be required.
- Scholarships may be renewed for up to three consecutive semesters as long as student maintains the required GPA and continues to meet department/athletic requirements.
- Scholarship dollar amounts may vary and will be determined by the division chair, coach/Athletic Director.
- Interested students should inquire through the appropriate Crowder College Department/Athletic Program.

\*A+ students are not eligible for Superintendent's, Trustees, or Presidential Honors Scholarships
