Neosho, MO – The Crowder College Speech and Debate team competed in the first tournament of the season at Southwest Baptist University, Bolivar, MO. Crowder competed against 18 schools representing seven states. The Novice squad took Top Community College and secured wins against some of the best schools in the state.

Students competing included:

Logan Johns (Diamond) placed in the top 15 in Dramatic Interpretation and Lincoln-Douglas debate. Christi Russow (Neosho) was the 8th ranked speaker overall as a Lincoln-Douglas debater and in the top 15 in Progral Oral Interpretation.
