STEPS FOR ADMISSION:

- 1. **Complete an application for admission online at www.crowder.edu.** The \$25 application fee may be paid at any campus or by calling the cashier's office with credit card information at 866-238-7788, extension 5598 or 5402.
- 2. **Placement exam:** A computerized placement exam that will help your academic advisor place you in the correct prerequisite classes. Call the Testing Center for an appointment: 417.455.5433.
- 3. Have your official high school transcript or GED/HiSet scores, plus any previous official college transcripts, sent to the Records Office.
- 4. Make payment arrangements.

Payment options include cash, payment plan, scholarship, and financial aid (apply for financial aid online at www.fafsa.ed.gov, using the Crowder College code: 002459). All A+ students must apply for financial aid. Payment arrangements must be completed prior to the beginning of classes.

5. Review the schedule of classes and make an appointment.
