ENTRY LEVEL HEALTHCARE OPPORTUNITIES

HOME HEALTH AIDE

TRAINING COST: \$595

40 HOURS + 32 HOURS OF CLINICALS

Teaches basic nursing care for the disabled, chronically ill, cognitively impaired, and older-adults needing assistance living in their own homes or residential facilities.

COMMUNITY HEALTH PACKAGE

TRAINING COST: \$130 OR \$75 PER CLASS

FIRST AID, C.P.R., AED, & BLOODBORNE PATHOGENS

Teaches basic first aid, C.P.R. Certification, AED, and Bloodborne pathogens. These pathogens include, but are not limited to, hepatitis B (HBV), hepatitis C (HCV) and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). Needlesticks and other sharps-related injuries may expose workers to bloodborne pathogens.

CPR (CARDIOPULMINARY RESUSCITATION) FOR HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS, BASIC LIFE SUPPORT

TRAINING COST: \$75

CARDIOPULMINARY RESUSCITATION

This class is great for teens, lifeguards, & healthcare providers.

CERTIFIED MEDICATION TECHNICIAN

TRAINING COST: \$595

This course is an expanded role of the Certified Nurse Assistant. This course is a preparatory course to prepare the individual for employment as a CMT in an intermediate care or skilled facility. This course teaches skills in administration of nonparenteral medications that will qualify students to perform this procedure to assist licensed practical nurses or registered professional nurses in medication therapy.

CERTIFIED NURSE ASSISTANT BRIDGE

TRAINING COST: \$595

The CNA Bridge is offered for a Home Health Aide to complete their CNA certification. This must be completed within six months of completing the HHA course. This course consists of 32 classroom and 100 clinical hours in a nursing home. At the completion of the CNA Bridge, the student will take a certification test to receive the Missouri State CNA certification.
