Strategic Direction Steering Committees

Purpose: To coordinate, support, and assess the work to advance the four strategic directions outlined in *Building on our B.A.S.E.: Crowder College Strategic Plan 2016-2020*.

Primary Charge:

- Develop a coordinated plan of action for each Strategy in the Plan;
- Foster a climate of cooperation and inclusion among employees and stakeholders;
- Serve as the advisory body which guides the work undertaken for each strategy;
- Act as the primary sounding board/collection body for all ideas to progress the plan;
- Continually monitor progress for each strategy;
- Continually monitor the Data and Targets for each Strategic Direction;
- Where appropriate, develop additional measurements specific to particular Strategies;
- Report progress monthly to College Council;
- Report progress and recommendations no less than quarterly to all employees;
- Make special reports to the Board as requested;
- Recommend to College Council additional strategies to be added to the Plan as appropriate; and
- During the annual budgeting process, outline and recommend to President's Council budget priorities to support Strategic Directions.

Team Recommendations:

- 1. Make certain key stakeholders have been included in the conversations and formulation of the recommendation. The Team is steering, but all who have a perspective, role, or stake in the recommendation should be consulted and involved in the formulation of the recommendation.
- 2. President's Council is a stakeholder is all things Crowder. All recommendations should be on the President's Council agenda as a discussion item at least once before moving to the approval process in College Council.
- 3. Recommendations must go before College Council for approval.
- 4. Depending on the nature of the recommendation, Board of Trustees approval may be required following College Council approval.
