MOTORCYCLE RIDERS COURSE

Crowder College
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Purpose

The purpose of the Motorcycle Rider Program is to provide quality instruction in safe riding techniques for beginning motorcyclists. Our goal is to increase your skill level and knowledge, in an attempt to produce a safe and conscientious motorcyclist.

What is the BRC?

The Basic Rider Course is designed to provide a foundation of knowledge and skills for people who have never ridden, as well as those who have ridden up to 10,000 miles. Motorcycles and helmets are provided.

Non-motorcyclists can benefit from this course by learning on a first-hand basis what a motorcyclist experiences and the necessity for developing respect for all vehicles on the roadway. The novice or occasional rider can benefit in the areas of skill development with emphasis for survival as a street rider.

Because the BRC course can be taken in lieu of the range-riding portion of the Missouri Department of Revenue license examination, successful completion of a written and skills evaluation is required to pass the course. Those who successfully complete the course will be issued a completion card from the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, which is recognized by many insurance companies for premium discounts.

In order to **Eligibility** register for the BRC, participants must be 15 1/2 years of age or older.

Parental consent required for: 15 1/2 years of age - up to 18 years of age.

Course Fee: \$225

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING REQUIRED

This clothing is required!

Long-Sleeved Jacket or Shirt-waist length of denim or other heavy material.
Eye Protection-sunglasses or prescription lenses for your convenience.
