

2022-2023 SCHOLARSHIPS

Crowder College offers Academic, Departmental, Athletic, Performance and Foundation Scholarships intended to assist students and their families in meeting college expenses. Multiple scholarships may be awarded based on student need and eligibility requirements. **A+ students are eligible for Honors or Academic scholarships. Tuition and common fees are paid by the state of Missouri through the A+ program when attending a community college.**University "A+ Scholarship" awards are not funded by the MO A+ Program and only cover a fraction of tuition and fees.

HONORS

Presidential Honors (The equivalent of full tuition, fees and books)

- Must apply and be accepted to Crowder's Honors Program. Applications and eligibility information available at: www.Crowder.edu/Academics/Honors
- Renewable for up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA, completion of at least 15 credit hours per semester and a "B" or above in all Honors coursework
- Fall priority deadline is March 1
- Honors recipients are not eligible for Academic Scholarships

ACADEMIC

- Academic Distinction Scholarship* (\$850 per semester, Fall/Spring)
- Each In-District school district nominates one student from the top 10% of the graduating high school class (Diamond, East Newton, McDonald County, Neosho, and Seneca)
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 15 credit hours per semester
- Interested students should inquire with your high school counselor

Center Scholarship* (\$800 per semester, Fall/Spring)

- High school graduates with a minimum 3.5 GPA & will attend the Center from which the scholarship is awarded
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Interested students may inquire at a Crowder Center (Cassville, Joplin ATTC, McDonald County, Nevada, or Webb City)
- Fall priority deadline is March 1

Trustees* (\$700 per semester, Fall/Spring)

- High school seniors graduating from an accredited high school, ranking in the top 15% of their class OR a student scoring a 25 or higher on the ACT (Includes high school and home school graduates.)
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Fall priority deadline is March 1

DEPARTMENTAL

Agriculture, Art & Design, Business & Office Administration, Journalism, Social Sciences, Teacher Education, Spanish, Speech/Debate, and Theatre

- Eligible students with a minimum departmental GPA and are enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Scholarship amounts may vary and will be determined by the division chair
- Interested students should inquire through the appropriate Crowder College Department

FOUNDATION

May be awarded by major or field of study, general or specific criteria based on donor request

- Application: Crowder.edu/scholarships
- Fall priority deadline is March 1

OTHER

Career & Technical Education (\$800 per semester-top ranked senior, \$400 per semester-2nd ranked senior from Technology Centers in Carthage, Crowder-Neosho, Lamar, Franklin-Joplin, Nevada, & Scott-Monett)

- Full-time enrollment within 1 year of high school graduation
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Inquire at Technology Center you attend for application

High School Equivalency Scholarship (\$650 per semester, Fall/Spring)

- Anyone who passed the High School Equivalency in Missouri, with a minimum score of 75
- The initial award must be used within the first year following HSE completion
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Inquire at Financial Aid Office

James Agriculture Scholarships (\$31,000 in scholarships available each year. Go to: crowder.edu/departments/agriculture/ to apply)

- L-EARN-er scholarship (\$1000 per semester, fall & spring): minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA; work in Ag Division 8 hr/week for 12 weeks; application, essay & references
- Ag LEADER scholarship (\$500 per semester, fall & spring): For FFA or 4-H Officers; minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA;
 leadership requirements, application and essay
- Legacy scholarships (\$500 per semester, fall & spring): parent must be an alumni; minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA; recruiting responsibilities; application and essay

CAMP (College Assistance Migrant Program (Pays tuition, books, and fees for your first year)

- Student, parent, or guardian have worked as a migrant or seasonal farm worker for at least 75 days of the last 24 months
- Interested students should inquire at the CAMP Office on the Neosho campus

Resident Assistant (Room & Board)

- Requires recipient to live in campus housing, work in various campus offices and be on call for emergencies
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA; and completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Interested students should inquire at the Campus Life Office

Student Ambassador (\$800 per semester, fall & spring)

- Students are required to work a minimum of 10 hours per week in Admissions Office
- Renewable up to six consecutive semesters with 2.5 cumulative GPA and minimum 12 hours completed per semester
- Scholarship prorated for summer semester and A+ students
- Applications available online at Crowder.edu/scholarships/student-ambassadors

PERFORMANCE | ATHLETIC

- Eligible students must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA and meet departmental/athletic requirements
- Auditions, tryouts, and/or portfolios may also be required
- Scholarships may be renewed for up to three consecutive semesters provided the student maintains the required GPA and continues to meet department/athletic requirements
- Scholarship amounts vary and will be determined by the division chair, coach/Athletic Director
- Interested students should inquire through the appropriate Crowder College Department/Athletic Program
