ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

STUDENT ENROLLS

Incoming students complete the standard procedure to gain admission and determine collegelevel placement.

ADVISOR OUTREACH

Advisors meet with students to determine UConnect candidacy, suggest opportunity, and enroll students into designated cohort, as indicated by course codes.

TITLE III CONFIRMATION

Title III CTE Advising Specialist confirms student enrollment and is designated as secondary advisor for student, communicating with the student thereafter.
