

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, or, will be 18 prior to graduating from the program and must:

- -Have a current American Heart Association Basic Life Support for Healthcare Provider (CPR) card that is current (if you cannot locate one prior to the onset of the semester, Crowder EMS Instructors may hold one)
- -Have a valid state driver's license
- -Have a high school diploma or GED
- -Submit a complete program application and all supporting documents
- -Show a positive appearance, motivation and attitude (in the clinical and field internship segments, the student will be working closely with patients, nurses, physicians and EMT's and must maintain a high degree of professionalism).
- -Successfully complete an interview with the advisory board or instructor(s) on the date and time provided
- -Be able to lift 150 pounds
- -Take and pass a criminal background check (no drug, sexual or violent offenses)
- -Show verification of TB skin test and negative reading
- -Hepatitis B: Proof of 1st inoculation of series prior to start of class; or if series is complete, proof of all inoculation dates; or proof of titer date and results.
- -Wonderlic reading score of 310 or higher and/or 18 on ACT
- -Be able to adapt to stressful situations
