The award was based on the spring 2013 publication. Winners will be notified in April and recognized at an awards ceremony Thursday, May 8 on the Neosho campus of Crowder College.

Since, 1980 the Quill has been published and distributed free on campus and in the community to "showcase and encourage artists and authors," said Bailey.
