Crowder officials and donors will be on hand to celebrate the grand opening of the James B. Tatum Hall. Area community members are encouraged to come see the new building during this time.

Crowder has been offering classes at various locations throughout McDonald County for several years. This new center offers a variety of general education classes as well as the new nursing program that was recently housed at the former lumberyard in Pineville.

Classes begin January 13th with enrollment available through the first week of classes. Crowder College has its main location in Neosho, but also has facilities in Webb City, Cassville and Nevada. Classes are also offered in Carthage, Greenfield, Lamar, Monett and Mt. Vernon. Crowder's enrollment over the last 8 years has doubled with 5,845 students attending classes in the fall 2013 semester.
