Crowder College Prepping New Housing for Students

Neosho, MO – Crowder College Residence Hall staff along with several employees are preparing the new Roughrider Village Apartments for the return of students by moving in new furniture. Trucks will be delivering new furnishings for the 64 unit Roughrider Village early Tuesday morning.

Each apartment will be furnished with a sofa, chair and coffee table in the living room area and bunkable beds in the bedrooms. "We are so excited for all our new students moving into their "home away from home" at Roughrider Village. The furniture will give our students all the comforts they need to excel in their studies and it gives them their first glimpse into independence away from home," state Mark Aubuchon, Campus Life Director.

Crowder College purchased the Roughrider Village earlier this year to alleviate the demand for housing on the Neosho campus. The apartments added an additional 200 bed spaces for Crowder students. This addition provides Crowder with on-campus housing to accommodate up to 400 students.

The Roughrider Village apartments are located directly across Hwy D/Doniphan Drive from the main campus. Apartments are one or two bedroom and may be rented starting this fall year round by students attending Crowder College full-time. They feature living room and kitchens with appliances.

The Brown Housing complex was constructed on the Neosho campus and opened in the fall of 2000. The suite style housing offers 6 bedrooms with a commons area and shared bathroom facilities. The Brown complex is located on the East side of campus.
