CROWDER COLLEGE'S INGRAM RECEIVES SENIOR SERVICE AWARD

Branson, Missouri – Wednesday, November 5. Crowder College's Cheryl Ingram received the Missouri Community College Association's Senior Service Award at a ceremony in Branson this afternoon. Ingram has been a math/computer instructor at Crowder since 1986, starting as a part-time instructor and moving into full-time work in 1993. In 2010, she became division chair for the math and physical science division. She also served as the Phi Theta Kappa advisor for five years and was named outstanding PTK advisor during that time. She received the Governor's Award for Excellence in Teaching in 2004.

This year marked MCCA's fiftieth annual convention. Association members celebrated the milestone by hosting several former community college leaders at the convention, including Dr. Norman Myers, founding president of Ozarks Technical Community College; Dr. Don Shook, founding president of East Central College, St. Charles Community College, and St. Charles Community College; and Dr. Jim Kellerman, former MCCA executive director.
