Crowder College Foundation Hosts Evening of Jazz and Branson Vacation Package Raffle

Neosho, MO—Crowder College Foundation will host the 6th Annual Evening of Jazz Tuesday, May 5 at the Neosho Civic. The event begins with a wine and hors d'oeuvres mixer at 6 pm followed by a live jazz performance by Crowder Jazz Orchestra at 7 pm. Gary Bandy will serve as master of ceremonies for the evening.
