All volunteers must:

- Be 18 years old or older;
- Be a native or fluent English speaker;
- Be willing to make a commitment of at least two hours a week;
- Have the desire to work with adults from different cultural, educational, and economic backgrounds
- Pass the Crowder College background test (paid for by the AEL program)
