Evening of Jazz Nears Sell-out

Neosho, MO—Tickets for Evening of Jazz, presented by Fred Clark and hosted by Crowder College Foundation, are selling quickly with only a very limited number of tickets still available. The event takes place Tuesday, April 26 at the Neosho Civic and begins with a wine and hors d'oeuvres mixer at 6 pm followed by a live jazz performance by Crowder Jazz Orchestra and dancing at 7 pm.

Former local news anchor and meteorologist Gary Bandy will serve as master of ceremonies for the evening. Tickets are \$30 per person and reserved tables of eight are \$275. Proceeds from the event will provide scholarship assistance for students with limited financial resources.

In conjunction with Evening of Jazz, chances for a fabulous Branson adventure package valued at more than \$2,400 may be purchased for \$5 each or \$20 for five chances. The drawing takes place during Evening of Jazz, but the winner does not need to be present.

Crowder Jazz Orchestra, an 18-piece band, features community and professional musicians who collectively have played with musical greats including Doc Severinsen, Joe Williams, Henry Mancini, Wayne Newton, Bob Mintzer, and the Woody Herman Orchestra.
