We will explain the concept of an energy audit for your house. You can expect to learn what appliances use the most energy, and how to use them more efficiently. The course will also cover what to spend extra money on when upgrading your insulation, windows, doors, and appliances and how to qualify for CASH incentives when upgrading.
