POSITION SUMMARY

Assists in the coaching of the Men's Soccer team which includes instruction in the rules, regulations, techniques, and team concepts of the sport, specific position instruction, game day coaching and instruction, practice planning and execution both during in- and off-season, recruitment, conditioning, supervision of athletes, maintenance of Men's Soccer facilities and equipment, and administrative tasks.

MAJOR FUNCTIONS

- 1. Provide instruction in all aspects of the game of Men's Soccer including fundamentals of the game, rules, regulations, techniques, and team concepts.
- 2. Provide specific position instruction.
- 3. Provide planning and execution of instruction during in- and off-season daily practices.
- 4. Provide game day instruction and coaching.
- 5. Perform recruiting activities to develop a competitive team.
- 6. Maintain Men's Soccer facilities. Perform pre-game and post-game facility preparation.
- 7. Perform weekly random room checks in the residence halls and enforce curfews.
- 8. Coordinate team travel arrangements, motel reservations, travel itineraries and make arrangements with food service for meals when games interfere with regular dining schedule.
- 9. Report game scores and information to the media, as needed, and to NJCAA each week.
- 10. Maintain stats internally as well as on the NJCAA website.
- 11. Coordinate equipment and field maintenance.
- 12. Assist the head coach with implementation, supervision, and coordination of fundraisers.
- 13. Supervise study hall and tutoring for student athletes.
- 14. Supervise and assist student athletes in community projects.
- 15. Maintain office hours and correspondence files.
- 16. Perform other related tasks as assigned by the Head Coach, Athletic Director and/or Vice President of Student Affairs.
