

Transfer Institution Recruitment and Campus Visit Guidelines

With increased enrollment and activities at all Crowder College site locations, need for improved consistency, and the strong relationships between Crowder and a number of regional four-year transfer partners, there is a need to clearly outline transfer recruiting and campus visit guidelines.

Crowder College welcomes any four-year institution interested in promoting their programs of study and transfer opportunities. The following guidelines have been implemented to increase efficiency, improve communication, limit disruptions, and ensure transfer success for all Crowder graduates. All students should be encouraged to complete their program of study with Crowder College prior to transferring.

- All requests for transfer recruitment and visits to the Neosho campus must be made through the
 Coordinator of Career and Transfer Services. Four-year colleges and universities may visit each campus
 location a maximum of two times each academic year, aside from Transfer Fairs or other campus
 events in which the university was invited during the semester. To schedule visits to extended campus
 locations, contact the campus. Information for all campus locations is included below.
- Recurring office hours and advising appointments are limited to institutions that offer courses at a Crowder College campus or have an agreement established with the Vice President of Academic Affairs. Hours must be coordinated with Academic Affairs, Career and Transfer Services, or the appropriate campus director.
- Crowder will allow transfer recruitment of each semester's graduates in identified capstone courses where potential transfer graduates (for clearly four-year programs) are attending. Class time will be made available, as allowed by the faculty, of the stated course.
- Crowder will provide a list of graduates, at the conclusion of each semester, per the transfer institution's request to the Vice President of Student Affairs' office.
- Crowder will post, share, and/or distribute college information which is specific to transfer students included transfer guides, transfer scholarship opportunities, etc.
- Crowder will provide access to students nearing graduation at transfer-specific events, as identified by the Student Success Center and Career and Transfer Services staff.
