## PROGRAM GUIDE: GENERAL STUDIES AA (CASSVILLE)

- Enroll full-time (15-16 hours per semester) at the Cassville campus starting Fall 2020
- Test scores to support college-level reading and math
- General Studies major (or other AA program requiring significant general studies courses)
- No application needed
- \$1,475 scholarship for all participants
- Offering courses in an 8-week format
- Cohort model encourages peer support

### ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

#### STUDENT ENROLLS

Incoming freshmen students complete the standard procedure to gain admission and determine college-level placement.

#### ADVISOR OUTREACH

Advisors meet with students to determine UConnect candidacy, suggest opportunity, and enroll students into designated cohort, as indicated by course codes.

#### TITLE III CONFIRMATION

Title III Curriculum Specialist confirms student enrollment and is designated as secondary advisor for student, communicating with the student thereafter.
