

## STEPS FOR ADMISSION:

- 1. Complete an application for admission online at [www.crowder.edu](http://www.crowder.edu).**  
The \$25 application fee may be paid at any campus or by calling the cashier's office with credit card information at 866.238.7788, 417.455.5598 or 417.455.5402.
- 2. Have your official high school transcript** or GED/HiSet scores, plus any previous official college transcripts, sent to the Records Office.
- 3. Make payment arrangements.** Payment options include cash, payment plan, scholarship, and financial aid (apply for financial aid online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov), using the Crowder College code: 002459). All A+ students must apply for financial aid. Payment arrangements must be completed prior to the beginning of classes.
- 4. Review the schedule of classes and make an appointment.**
