Current Crowder Business Student Scholarship:

- \$250 - \$500 *non-renewable* scholarship for the Spring 2022 semester
- Will be awarded during the Spring 2022 semester after requirements have been met and verified by the Business Division Chair

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must attend Crowder College during the Spring 2022 semester
- Must be a declared business major: AA Business Administration, AA Information Technology, AAS Business - Management, or AAS Business - Accounting
- Must be full-time student (minimum 12 hours per semester)
- Must be enrolled in at least one business class during the Spring 2022 semester (ACCT, BSAD, BMGT, or ITC)
- Must have and maintain at least a 3.0 grade point average

- This application with all relevant information must be received by February 4th
