## BEHAVIOR TECHNICIAN DEGREE OPTION *Certificate*

The Behavior Technician program emphasizes Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) theories and techniques. This is an excellent program for people working with children with autism in an academic or health care setting. The certificate offers hands-on learning to practice concepts through field experience at the Maddox Hill Center. The program may be completed in two semesters and may be extended for students seeking their AA degree. (A+ Program Eligible)

### WHAT WOULD I BE DOING?

Working one-on-one or in a small group with students with autism spectrum disorder, developmental disabilities or behavior challenges in an educational or health care setting. This program provides an awareness and a “toolbox” of intervention strategies to build student skill sets. The strategies focus on evidence-based-interventions that foster greater academic performance, self-help skills, social skills and positive behavior changes.
